Skilled Worker Application – Information Required

* Indicates only required for applications from inside the UK

* Indicates only required for applications from outside the UK

1. Do you have a valid national identity card from a non-UK government?
If yes, details will be required – the ID number, country of issue, valid from and expiry date.
2. Have you ever been known by another name?
If yes, details will be required.
3. Do you hold or have you ever held another nationality?
If yes, details will be required.
4. Your current address and the dates you have lived here.
5. If you have not lived here for 2 years, you will need your address history for the last 2 years.
6. Information on whether you own this home, rent, or live with friends or family?
If you rent, information on your landlord (name, address and contact number) will be required.
7. The address of where you will be living in the UK.
8. Since you started living in the UK have you spent more than 2 weeks out of the country at one time? If yes, details will be required.
9. Do you have a partner?
If yes, details will be required.
10. Have you been married or in a civil partnership before?
If yes, details will be required.
11. Information on your parents: full names, dates of birth and country of nationality, and if they have always had the same nationality?
12. Do you have any family in the UK? I.e., partner, mother father or children?
If yes, details will be required

13. The date you plan to arrive in the UK.

14. The date you started living in the UK.

15. Information on how you proved your English language in your previous application.
A copy will be required.

16. How many times have you travelled to the following countries in the last 10 years?

- Australia
- Canada
- New Zealand
- USA
- Switzerland
- European Economic Area (do not include travel to the UK?)

17. Details of your last 2 trips to the above countries – including country travelled to, reason for travel i.e., tourism, work etc, date you arrived and how long you stayed for.

18. Have you been to any other countries in the last 10 years not listed above?
If yes, information will be required on countries travelled to, reason for travel i.e., tourism, work etc and date you arrived and date you left.

19. How many times have you been to the UK in the last 10 years?
Details will be required of your last 3 trips, reason for travel, dates you arrived and how long you stayed?

20. Did you receive any medical treatment while here in the UK?
If yes, details will be required.

21. Do you have any upcoming travel plans?

22. Do you have a national insurance number? If yes, details will be required.

23. Do you have a UK driving licence? If yes, details will be required.

24. Have you been sponsored by a government or international scholarship agency within the last 12 months?
If yes, details will be required.

25. Have you ever worked in any of the following jobs:
If yes, details will be required.

- Armed Forces
- Government
- Intelligence services
- Security organisations
- Media Organisations
- Judiciary.
